

## Announcement of the Office of the Judiciary on the Will on Administration in Good Faith

According to the National Anti-corruption Strategy - Phase 3 (2017 – 2021), the proactive measure on preventing corruption has been stipulated as a significant strategic action to prevent and suppress corruption in the public sector. This measure conforms to the performance of the Office of the Judiciary in the development of the integrity and transparency assessment system of the Court of Justice, including the effective mechanism and system of preventing corruption. As a consequence, judicial service officers, court personnel and employees shall perform their duties as provided by laws, by upholding the codes of conduct, and deliver justice in a timely and fair manner without prejudice under the policy of the President of the Supreme Court and the mission as specified in the Strategic Plan of the Court of Justice (2018 – 2021), which is to administer justice for equality and social equity. In this regard, the Office of the Judiciary deems appropriate to announce the will on administration in good faith to judicial service officers, court personnel and the public for the purpose that the Office of the Judiciary and its affiliated agencies shall perform with honesty by prioritizing people's interest, elevating virtue and transparency and creating organizational culture based on the accountability system together with the awareness of suppressing corruption and exercising action against it. This also includes non-participation in any affair which may lead to a conflict of interest. As a result, the public can be equally and indiscriminately provided with justice and this will ultimately be beneficial to the people and trust in the Court of Justice.
